Direct Costs:

Tuition & Fees Calculations (full time calculation at 15 credits a term)

Tuition: \$126 per credit x 15 credits = \$1,890.00 tuition only

Fees: \$13.00 per credit x 15 credits = \$195.00

General Fee: \$30 per term

Books – This is an average amount a student might spend on books and supplies.

Transportation - Transportation is for gas/fuel, insurance and maintenance of a vehicle, or alternative commuting costs such as bus pass or fare.

Personal – This is an estimate of what a student might spend on personal items, clothing, recreation and travel.

Indirect costs are what a student would expect to pay for housing, food and utilities while attending CCC.

Indirect Costs:

Living Expenses - CCC is considered a commuter campus. Living Expenses are based on the median cost of an apartment located within Clackamas County, as well as utilities and food based on national averages for students. Documentation will be required if a student believes that their costs exceed the budget estimation.
