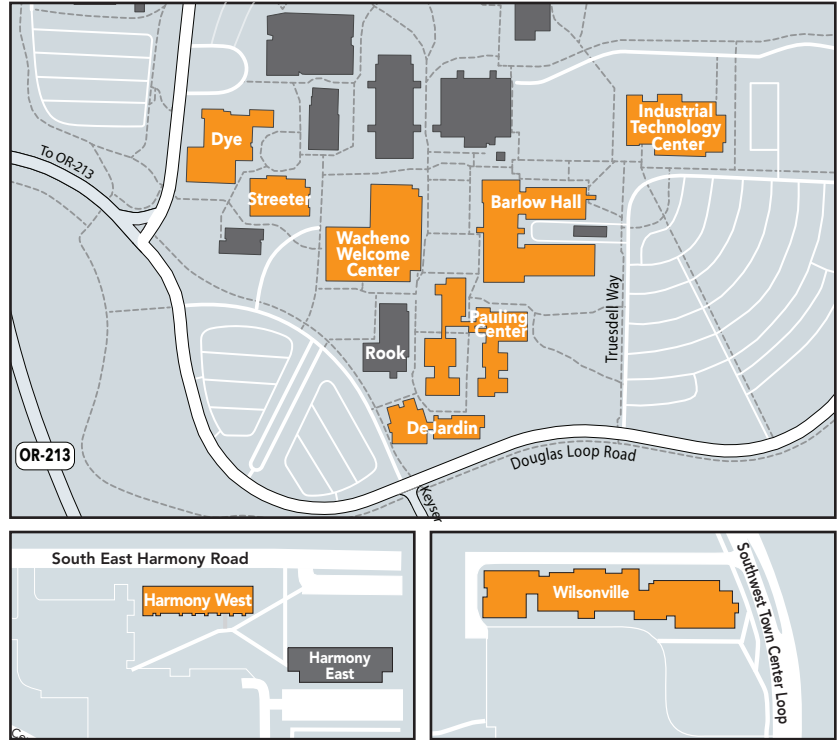


Where Can I Study?

A STEM focused study spot, room for student-organized study groups, and student hours hosted by STEM faculty. STREETER: Quiet Computer Lab, room 137. Four dedicated computers with web cameras, headsets, and loaded with Zoom. WACHENO: Outside Start Lab (WC151), outside WC130 and near the Welcome Desk, individual study rooms near Cougar Café on a first come first served basis. Harmony: Computer access in Harmony West 110, Harmony East lobby and HE 240. Small conference rooms are available for student use in Harmony West on a first come, first served basis.
